This occurs through the exploration of alcohol and other drug problems and/or addiction and their ramifications, including an examination of attitudes and feelings, consideration of alternative solutions and decision making and/or discussing information related to alcohol and other drug-related problems. Group counseling services shall be provided at a program site certified by the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services or in the client's natural environment. And Referral - AOD	Prevention Problem Identification and Referral Service refers to any activity designed as a prevention service aimed at identification of those individuals who have indulged in illegal/age-inappropriate use of tobacco and/or alcohol and those who have indulged in the first use of illicit drugs in order to assess if their behavior can be reversed through education. This strategy does NOT include any activity designed to determine if a person is in need of treatment.
